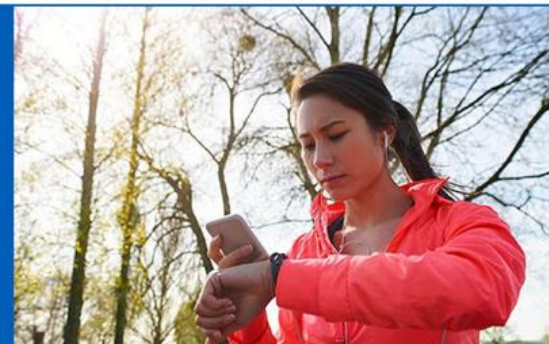
NHS Apps Library

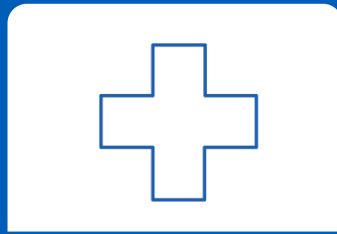

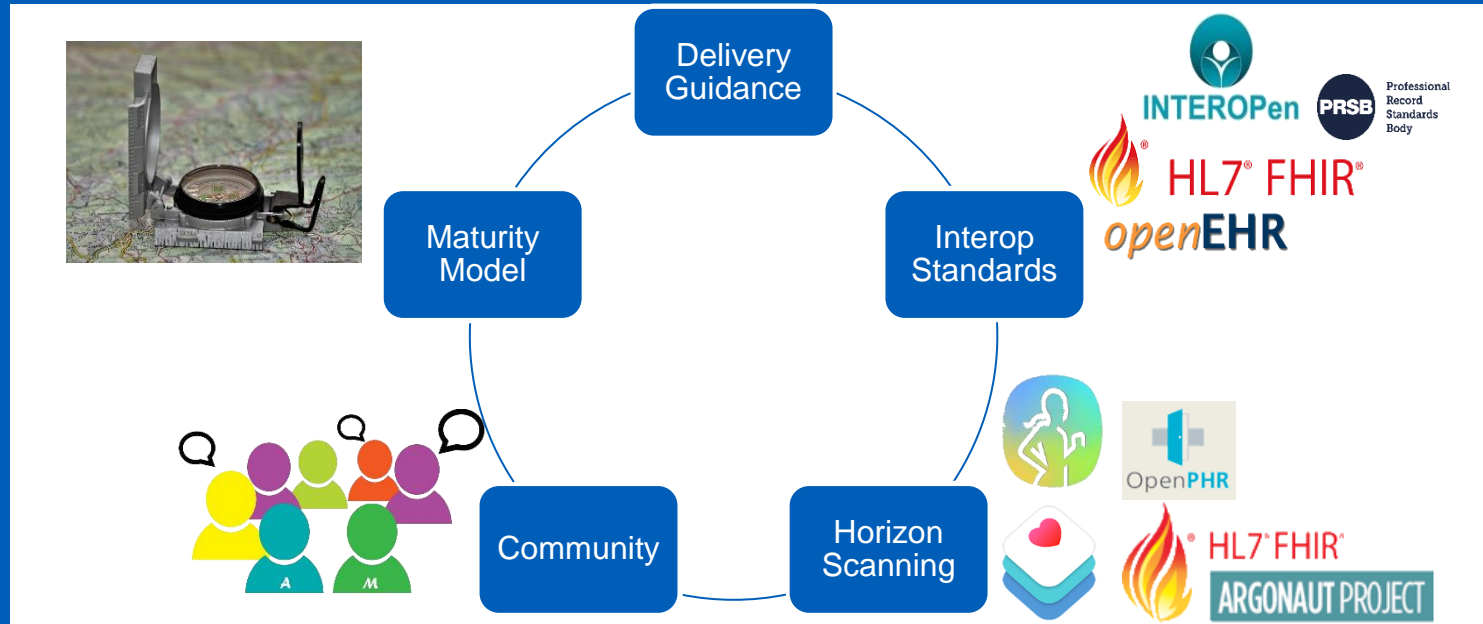

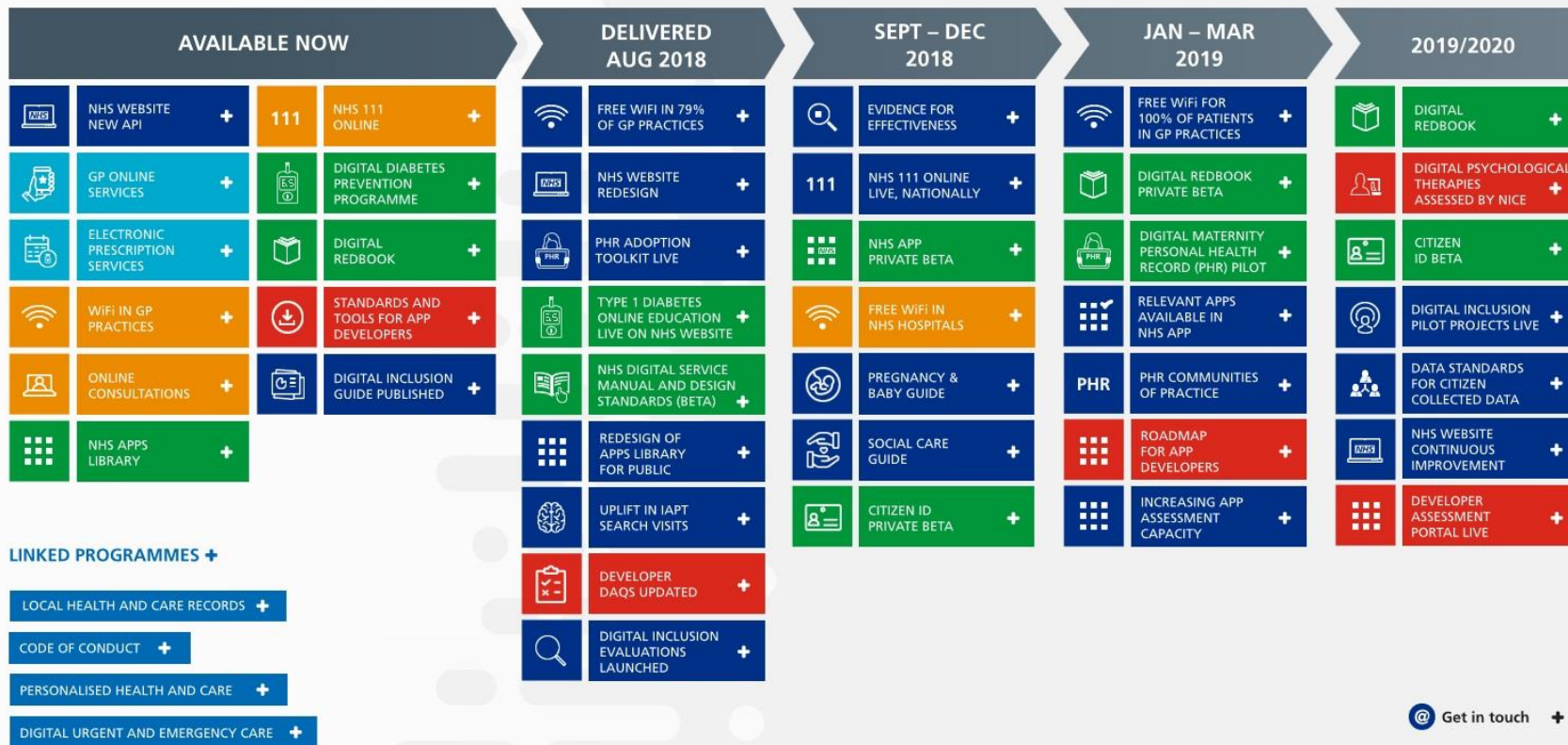
